Existing and Functional Material Resources

The school is equipped with:

- **20 classrooms**, each furnished with ergonomic furniture, a projector, a projection screen, a magnetic board, a computer, graphic tablets, internet connection (two networks), printers, and a state-of-the-art audio-video recording system for lesson transmission.
- **Electronic gradebook.**
- **A computer lab** (interactive whiteboard, 22 networked computers, appropriate furniture).
- **A science lab** equipped for required activities (interactive whiteboard, laptop, printer).
- **An educational support office** (one school psychologist, one support teacher).
- **A Documentation and Information Center**, fully equipped.
- **A medical office** (one school doctor, one nurse).

The school has **38 computers**, distributed as follows:

- **25 for students**
- **3 for teaching staff**
- **10 for administration**

The school is equipped with an **indoor and outdoor surveillance system** and has independent heating, natural and artificial lighting, and running water. It has a **health and safety authorization**, a **security plan approved by the Dorohoi Police Department**, and a **risk analysis registry approved by the Botoșani County Police Inspectorate**.

Sports Facilities

- An **outdoor sports field**.



- A gymnasium with a **special rubber-covered floor** (800 square meters).
